Historic Society Campaigns to Save Calle Grande Arches

The Holly Hill Historic Preservation Society has started a campaign to have the Calle Grande Arches restored. As reported in our last newsletter, the arches were damaged when struck by a vehicle. The insurance company has sent a check for \$100,000 to repair them. It is estimated that is will take \$450,000 to fully restore the complete structure. Rumors surfaced that the County felt they were not worth repairing and suggested razing the historic structure. Members appeared at the recent Volusia County Historic board meeting to convince them to save them. Thanks to many calls and letters the commission is reconsidering.

Have a happy and safe 4th of July! 1. Never give fireworks to small children and always follow the instructions

- on the packaging.
- 2.Keep a supply of water close by as a precaution.
- 3. Make sure the person lighting fireworks always wears eye protection.
 4. Light only one firework at a time and never attempt to relight "a dud."
- 5. Store fireworks in a cool, dry place away from children and pets
- 6. Never throw or point a firework toward people, animals, vehicles, structures or flammable materials.
- 7. Leave any area immediately where untrained amateurs are using fireworks 8. Florida law prohibits any fireworks that fly through the air or explode for recreational use.
